RULES AND REGULATIONS

Starting Time: The schooling ring opens at 7:00am. The show begins at 8:00am or 10:00am depending on the ring. Please check the class list for start of ring.

Fees: \$30.00 Pre-entriesmust be received paid in full not later then October 19,2025. \$35.00 Post entries per class with the exception of the Jumper & Hunter Classic. Jumper & Hunter Classic is a \$75 entry fee and requires a six competitor minimum. Schooling passes are \$20.00. A \$25.00 per horse haul in/grounds fee is mandatory by the order of The Horse Park Of NJ (if not stabling). Stall rentals are \$85.00 per stall per day. Entry form will not be accepted unless signed by owner/agent, trainer, rider and/or legal guardian of minor A hard copy of a current (within one calendar year) negative coggins report is required by order of the Horse Park of NJ. A current health certificate is required for out of state entries. SORRY, NO REFUNDS All non-refundable money will be treated as a donation to The All Thoroughbred Charity Horse Show.

General Rules: 1.) Show will be held rain or shine! 2.) Martingales are not permitted in under saddle classes. 3.) Appropriate schooling attire is required, heeled boots and ASTM certified helm ets. 4.) Second Call Inc. and it's owners, operators, employees, and other entities will not be responsible for damage, injury, or loss to any person, animal or property of exhibitors or spectators occurring at this show. 5.) Dogs must be on a leash \$20 no leash fine order of the Horse Park of NJ. 6.) Please use appropriate trash and manure containers.

Prizes: A trophy and six ribbons will be awarded for each class. With the exception of Classes 24 & 41 where cash is also awarded in addition to ribbon and trophy.

Thoroughbred Only: You must show proof of TB Registration (*One* of the following is required: Micro chip, lip tattoo, copy of registration, or JC papers).

Jockey Club T.I.P.: JC TIP award forms must be turned into the secretaries office prior to showing.

Dressage: Dressage will be judged according to the USEF rules. All entries must be submitted by October 18, 2025 to assure accurate ride times.

Dressage Ride Times: All Ride times will emailed to riders on or about October 23rd

Fresh Off The Track: All horses entered must be off the track less then one year.
